EMERGENCY CLOSURE ORDER

Effective this 18th day of March 2020 at 12:00 p.m. BY ORDER of the Chief Justice, ALL COURT OPERATIONS, including scheduled sittings at the Courthouse in Iqaluit together with Court Registry operations, have been suspended until further notice pursuant to Practice Directive #37.

All matters scheduled to proceed to hearing during this period of closure are hereby adjourned to 9:30a.m. on Monday, June 1, 2020.

All filing deadlines that fall within this period of emergency closure are hereby extended to the close of business on June 1, 2020, the next full day that the Court resumes normal operations.

Any remand warrant, warrant of committal, removal order, subpoena, summons or other court process that is returnable during this period of emergency closure shall continue in full force and effect until the close of business on June 1, 2020, the next full day after the Court resumes normal operations.

All persons affected by this emergency closure are required to attend Court at 9:30 a.m. on Monday, June 1, 2020.

Notwithstanding the suspension, to allow for the continued administration of the courts, bail hearings, detention reviews, child welfare prescribed appearances, and urgent, in-custody matters brought forward and approved through a supplemental docket request, will continue, via phone, as operations permit.
