**THIS COURT ORDERS** that the Public Guardian for Nunavut be appointed GUARDIAN for the Respondent pursuant to section 7 of the *Guardianship and Trusteeship Act*, **AND THAT FOR THIS PURPOSE** the Guardian may:

- 1. decide where the represented person is to live, temporarily or permanently, s. 11(2)(a);
- 2. decide with whom the represented person is to live, s.11(2)(b);
- 3. decide with whom the represented person is to consort, s.11(2)(c);
- 4. decide whether the represented person may engage in social activities and, if so, the nature and extent of the social activities, s.11(2)(d);
- 5. decide whether the represented person should work and, if so, the nature or type of work, for whom he or she is to work and related matters, s.11(2)(e);

- 9. consent to any type of health care, s.11(2)(j);
- 10. consent to the withdrawal of or withholding of life support systems used for the represented person, s.11(2)(k);
- 11. make normal day to day decisions on behalf of the represented person including the diet and dress of the represented person, s.11(2)(I);
- 12. consent to the restraint or confinement of the represented person, s.11(2)(m);
- 13. consent to the termination of the represented person's parental rights, s.11(2)(n);
- 14. make or withdraw a direction under the *Human Tissue Act* on behalf of the represented person, s.11(2)(o);
