THIS COURT ORDERS that the Public Guardian for Nunavut be appointed GUARDIAN for the Respondent pursuant to section 7 of the *Guardianship and Trusteeship Act*, **AND THAT FOR THIS PURPOSE** the Guardian may:

11. _____ make normal day to day decisions on behalf of the represented person including the diet and dress of the represented person, s.11(2)(l);
12. _____ consent to the restraint or confinement of the represented person, s.11(2)(m);

14. _____ make or withdraw a direction under the *Human Tissue Act* on behalf of the represented person, s.11(2)(o);

THIS COURT DIRECTS the Public Guardian to provide the nearest relative of the represented person with an annual report on the Respondent's circumstances. The Public Guardian shall arrange one visit per year between the represented person and two family members if requested by the family. It is strongly recommended that the travel and accommodation costs associated with this trip be paid for by the Department of Health and Social Services.

THIS COURT DOES FURTHER DIRECT that service of this order where required by the *Guardianship and Trusteeship Act* may be done by registered mail.
