

# EXTRAORDINARY SUPPLEMENTAL DOCKET REQUEST

## (FORM 10B)

The Nunavut Court of Justice requires 5 business days notice for matters to appear on the NCJ docket. For new charges, the five days should be calculated from the date the information is laid. For matters to be rescheduled from currently scheduled dockets or brought forward, the NCJ requires as a general rule, the request to be made by no later than the Friday before the scheduled appearance. For matters being adjourned from circuit, the matter must be adjourned at least five business days following the close of a community circuit. If counsel wish to have matters rescheduled outside of these parameters, they must complete this form and notify the Court if their requests are extraordinary. If you are making an extraordinary request on circuit **this form must be filed with the Clerk on the circuit prior to the close of circuit.**
